Mount Assiniboine Provincial Park British Columbia, Canada

This remote area of the Canadian Rockies is famed for the geological and ecological significance of its mountain landscapes containing the habitats of rare and endangered species. Lofty mountains, alpine meadows, glaciers, lakes, waterfalls, canyons and limestone caves form a landscape of superb natural beauty. Mount Assiniboine, 3,618m high, with a distinctive pyramidal shape, is situated in the park, soaring above its neighbouring peaks.

New York City New York, USA

The Statue of Liberty is a colossal statue on Liberty Island, Upper New York Bay, a welcome sight for arrivals to the USA and the city's most famous landmark. Standing 93m high, it represents a woman holding a torch and a tablet bearing the date of the Declaration of Independence. Skyscrapers have dominated the cityscape since the late 19th century and the new One World Trade Center now surpasses the Empire State Building as the city's tallest.

Old Town of Šibenik Croatia

The oldest native town in Croatia, once the seat of kings, Šibenik nestles in a sea inlet on the Dalmatian coast, with a wealth of historic buildings in Venetian Gothic and Renaissance styles. From the seaside promenade, stairs sweep up to St James Cathedral, built from the local white stone. Narrow streets and alleyways lead up to the citadel of St Michael's Fortress with sublime views over the Šibenik bay entrance.

Haew Suwat Waterfall Khao Yai National Park, Thailand

This enchanting waterfall, surrounded by lush vegetation, cascades from a cliff 20m high. At the bottom of the waterfall is a pool and stream that you can swim in, depending on the season, and there are spots for viewing the falls from the cliffs. Established in 1962 as Thailand's first national park, Khao Yai National Park is the third largest in Thailand. Elephants, macaques, gibbons, porcupines, civets and other more elusive species can be seen.

Mount Kilimanjaro Kenya

At 5,895m, Kilimanjaro is Africa's highest mountain. This volcanic massif stands in isolation above the surrounding plains, with its snowy peak and glaciers looming over the savannah. It is one of the world's largest volcanoes with three main peaks. Kilimanjaro National Park covers five vegetation zones: lower slopes, montane forest, heath and moorland, alpine desert and summit. It is home to numerous mammals, many of them endangered species.

Rangiroa Atoll Tuamotu Islands French Polynesia

Swaying palm trees fringe an idyllic beach on the western edge of the Rangiroa atoll, the largest in the Tuamotus and one of the world's largest atolls. Here, a string of white sand islands and reefs have formed a natural pool on the edge of the main reef, a lagoon within a lagoon with waters of stunning shades of blue. This exotic spot is reached by boat from nearby Avatoru. The coral reef teems with reef sharks, manta rays and colourful fish.

Chittorgarh Fort Rajasthan, India

One of six majestic forts in Rajasthan, built by the Rajput princely states that flourished from the 8th to 18th centuries, Chittorgarh Fort is among India's largest forts, dating from AD734. Sprawling over a 180m hill, above the surrounding plains, it is accessed by a steep zigzag road and seven huge gateways guarded by watchtowers. Inside the defensive walls there are four palace complexes, 19 main temples, and 20 lakes, reservoirs and wells.

Flinders Ranges South Australia

Starting 200km north of Adelaide, stretching over 430km to Lake Callabonna, the Flinders Ranges are the largest mountain ranges in South Australia. This area of vibrant red, furrowed mountains, with towering cliffs, deep craters and creeks, has geological and palaeontological significance, as some of the oldest fossil evidence of animal life was discovered here. The Adnyamathanha people have inhabited the range for tens of thousands of years.

Porto Portugal

The bustling Ribeira district is the historic centre of Porto, with colourful medieval houses, Baroque churches and bell towers sweeping down to the waterfront. Port wine has been produced exclusively in the Douro valley since the 17th century and traditional rabelo boats transported barrels of port from the vineyards. The iconic two-deck Dom Luis I Bridge spans the Douro, linking the Ribeira area with the port wine houses of Vila Nova de Gaia.

Gyeongbokgung Palace Seoul, South Korea

Dating from 1395, this is the largest and most striking of the Five Grand Palaces of the Joseon dynasty. It was the home of the royal family and seat of government. Destroyed by fire in the 1590s and again during the Second World War, it is now restored. There are over 300 buildings within the walled palace complex, such as the National Folk Museum and the National Palace Museum. A reenactment of the Royal Guard Changing Ceremony is held twice daily.

Canal, Rozenhoedkaai Bruges, Belgium

The beautifully preserved historic centre of Bruges is encircled by city walls and criss-crossed by a network of canals. One of the most picturesque spots in the medieval city, with a weeping willow tree brushing the water, the Rozenhoedkaai, or Quay of the Rosary, was a mooring place for salt traders to unload their cargoes. The Belfry Tower, seen in the background, stands in the Grote Markt. Its carillon of 47 bells chimes every 15 minutes.

Matterhorn Gornergrat Bahn, Switzerland

The Matterhorn is Switzerland's most famous landmark, a formidable mountain with four steep faces towering 4,478m above Zermatt, near the Italian border. The route to the summit is highly exposed and dangerous. The Gornergrat Bahn opened in 1898, the world's first fully electrified cog railway, taking passengers from Zermatt to the Gornergrat viewing platform at 3,100m with a fine panorama of the Matterhorn, and the surrounding peaks and glaciers.
