Sluishuis, Amsterdam, Netherlands

At the edge of Amsterdam's IJmeer, rising 40m from the water, this block of 442 energy-neutral apartments surrounds an internal harbour with a double cantilever that forms a gateway. It is experienced differently from every angle, elevated on one side and stepped down on the other.

Merdeka Tower, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia

One of the world's tallest skyscrapers, 679m high, built in 2023, this narrow tower consisting of triangular glass planes and a 160m spire is set next to the Merdeka Stadium. The mixed-use design with an observatory floor is fully integrated with the city's rail networks.

One Za'abeel Towers, Dubai, UAE

Measuring 67.5m, the world's longest cantilever forms part of a horizontal structure called The Link, a bridge, dramatically suspended between two skyscrapers at the mixed-use One Za'abeel development, soaring 100m above a six-lane highway and topped by a giant infinity pool.

Shougang Bridge, Beijing, China

The world's first twin-tower cable-stayed steel composite bridge has two asymmetrical arch-shaped towers symbolising the city's gates. With a main span of 639m over the Yongding River and a total length of 1,354m, it is Beijing's longest bridge and China's widest steel bridge at 54.9m.

8 Bishopsgate, London, UK

This 50-storey mixed-use splits into three sections that step progressively back from the street line. It includes high sustainability and low energy initiatives – an elegant mix of materials, high levels of natural light, excellent air quality and a public viewing gallery, The Lookout.

Surat Diamond Bourse, Surat, India

The world's largest office (660,000m²) and the largest diamond trading hub, a 'one-stop destination' for 65,000 diamond cutters, polishers and traders, features nine rectangular structures interconnected by a central 'spine'. The atriums were designed to encourage natural ventilation.

St. Regis, Chicago, USA

A 101-storey hotel and residential tower and the tallest skyscraper designed by a woman. Based on a frustum, a geometric design in a truncated pyramid form, it consists of three linked towers, called 'stems' with differing heights, each alternated to create an undulating, sculpted feel.

Axel Springer Campus, Berlin, Germany

Built on the old border between East and West Berlin, the cube-shaped building offers 52,000m² of workspace and is characterised by its open and transparent architecture. A 45m-high, lightfilled atrium divides it into sections, giving a perpetual visual encounter for 3,000 employees.

Deansgate Square South Tower, Manchester, UK

Deansgate Square residential skyscraper cluster consists of four towers, the South Tower being the tallest at 201m. They sit at different angles to each other, with a slight bevel on each side providing an elegant, slim form and ensuring they catch the light at different times of day.

6th Street Bridge, Los Angeles, USA

Known as 'The Ribbon of Light' the new bridge replaced the original 6th Street Viaduct, built in 1932 over the LA River. The viaduct's fluid design includes ten pairs of arches, rising and falling along the north and south edges of the bridge with stunning views of LA on all sides.

One Park Drive, Canary Wharf, London, UK

Cylindrical in shape, with 484 apartments and penthouses over 57 storeys, this residential tower adds a new dimension to an area dominated by commercial space. White terracotta and offset balconies define the appearance of the façade and infuse it with a fine, structured character.

Rundeskogen, Sandnes, Norway

On a wooded hill by the coast, this hybrid concrete and timber construction of three residential towers in a prismatic shape plan contains 113 units with views across the landscape and generous social spaces. The first floors have been lifted off the ground, cantilevering from the core.
